Goals:

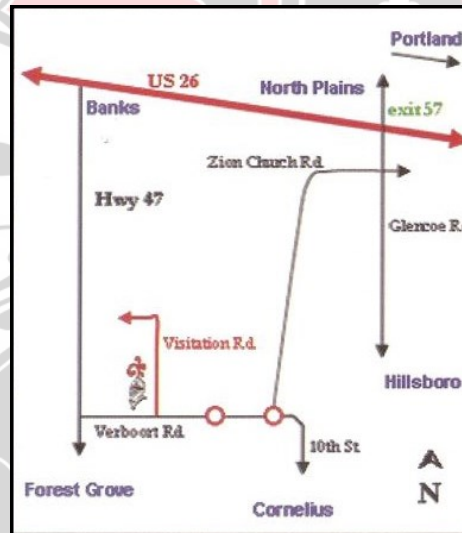

Key Areas of Study

Grades K - 2

- ◆ Students will learn vocabulary used in daily life such as food, body parts, family, nature and animals
- ◆ Students will learn short, commonly-used phrases such as greetings, and common, simple questions and answers
- ◆ Students will learn short songs and rhymes and be exposed to native art
- ◆ Students will learn the alphabet in Spanish and be able to recognize some short words
- ◆ We will learn about and celebrate holidays such as Christmas, various Independence Days, Day of the Dead and Cinco de Mayo

Grades 3 - 6

- ◆ Students will be able to express ideas more completely recalling vocabulary and sentence structure
- ◆ Students will learn present-tense verb conjugations
- ◆ Students will be able to read short, simple paragraphs in Spanish
- ◆ Younger students will compose short skits, and older students will present an oral and written report on a chosen Spanish-speaking country
- ◆ We will learn about and celebrate holidays such as Christmas, various Independence Days, Day of the Dead and Cinco de Mayo

Grades 7 - 8

- ◆ Students will be able to speak and write with more confidence and fluency
- ◆ Students will practice their skills through more complex exercises and dialogues
- ◆ Students will reach a higher level of listening and reading comprehension
- ◆ Students will learn past as well as present-tense verb conjugations and learn pro-noun usage
- ◆ Students will present an oral and written report on a chosen Spanish-speaking country
